

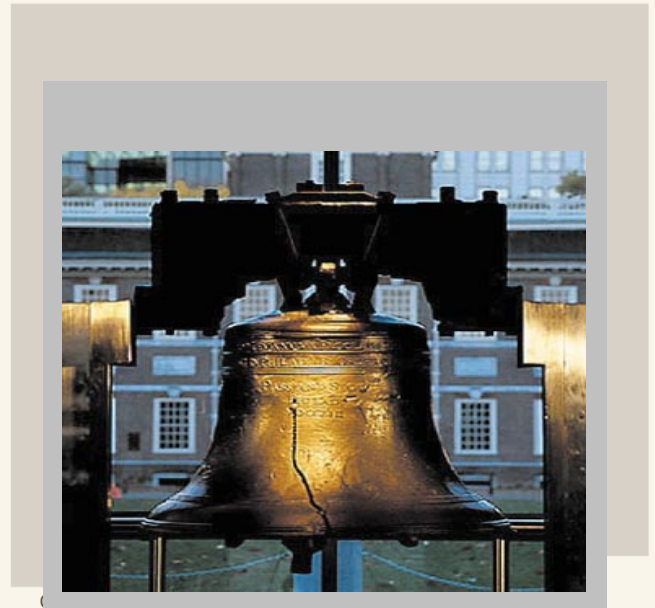
**JOIN US FOR THE NAIA-ATA
